




### MAGLEŠ MOUNTAIN (1036M)

The mountain is 23km away from Valjevo. It lies to the northeast of Povlen mountain and it is a part of it. In spite of being easily accessible by road, the mountain is less popular with tourists. Magleš is especially famous for its funnel-shaped holes, distinctive landscape of coniferous forests and meadows that can be found on its stunning slopes.



### MALJEN MOUNTAIN (1108M)

The mountain lies to the south of Valjevo. Apart from being famous for being a home to pine forests, the mountain is also known for its flower-rich meadows. The meadows are covered with white daffodils, the most beautiful mountain flowers that bloom in May. The landscape becomes even more impressive during the winter and it is the place that offers a wide variety of winter sports. Divčibare, a well-known mountain resort and also known as an air spa, is a mountain plateau located in the central section of Maljen Mountain.



### MEDVEDNIK MOUNTAIN (1247M)

The mountain is known as a bear-shaped mountain, due to its striking resemblance to a silhouette in the form of a bear. It is 25km away from Valjevo. The mountain with its untouched nature allows you to enjoy its stunning and mysterious landscape. The mountain hut, which is the starting point for plenty of trips and guided tours, is located on the mountain.

### JABLANIK MOUNTAIN (1247M)

The mountain is located at the source of the Jablanica River. It is 35 km away from Valjevo. A mountain hut, located on Debelo Brdo, is the place where tourists and hikers can meet. It takes 2 hours to get to Medvednik Mountain from here. Pustnja Monastery lies in the canyon of the Jablanica River. The monastery was built in 1622 and it is dedicated to the Presentation of the Virgin.

### POVLEN MOUNTAIN (1346M)

Povlen mountain is the highest mountain in the area. It is a home to the source of the Sušica River. The mountain is covered with forests but there are plenty of meadows and mountain clearings, as well. Due to its striking beauty and unique landscape it is considered as one of the most beautiful mountain in the area.
